Foundation Charter and Ethical Code

1. Identity and Legal Status

Fair Future Foundation is a Swiss non-profit humanitarian medical foundation established in February 2008, operating in the field since 2006.

We work primarily in ultra-rural regions where access to healthcare, clean water, sanitation, education and electricity remains critically limited.

We are a medical foundation above all else.

Our work is grounded in clinical rigour, scientific evidence, field presence and long-term commitment.

The Foundation is politically neutral, non-denominational and strictly independent.

2. Our Mission

Our mission is to improve the health, dignity and autonomy of vulnerable populations by providing:

- Structured primary medical care
- Disease prevention and epidemiological action
- Access to clean water and sanitation
- Health education and child protection
- Renewable energy solutions, when relevant
- Community empowerment through training and participation

We do not replace public systems.

We reinforce fragile environments to prevent collapse.

Each action is measurable, documented and evaluated.

3. Scientific and Clinical Approach

Our interventions are based on medical science and field data.

We design programs through:

- Epidemiological assessments
- Local health data analysis
- Clinical observation and diagnostic protocols
- Collaboration with health centres and authorities
- Continuous training of community health agents



Medical decisions are guided by evidence-based practice.

Prevention campaigns, malaria control strategies, sanitation projects and health education tools are structured around scientific knowledge adapted to local realities.

We believe that humanitarian medicine must be both compassionate and precise.

4. Methodology and Community Participation

Our approach is participatory.

We work with communities, not above them.

All projects are developed in consultation with:

- Local leaders
- Health authorities
- Schools and teachers
- Families
- Community volunteers

Our objective is autonomy, not dependency.

- We reject condescension.
- We refuse domination models.
- We promote local capacity building.

Training of community health agents is central to our methodology, ensuring that knowledge remains within the community long after our interventions.

5. Role of Local Representations

Fair Future Foundation operates through its Swiss governance structure and its official local representation in Indonesia.

The Swiss Foundation Board ensures:

- Strategic orientation
- Financial oversight
- Legal compliance
- Ethical supervision

The local representation ensures:

- Field implementation
- Operational coordination
- Liaison with authorities
- Monitoring and reporting
- Respect for local laws and cultural context

All entities operate under one unified ethical and medical framework.

Transparency and accountability apply equally at all levels.

6. Environmental Responsibility

Health and the environment are inseparable. Water scarcity, pollution, waste mismanagement and climate instability directly affect public health.

We commit to:

- Promoting sustainable water systems
- Encouraging waste reduction and responsible disposal
- Supporting renewable energy solutions
- Limiting the environmental impact of our logistics
- Educating communities on environmental health risks

Infrastructure projects are designed with durability and ecological responsibility in mind.

We believe that protecting ecosystems is part of protecting human life.

7. Child Protection and Safeguarding

Children are at the core of our interventions. In accordance with our Child Protection Policy

We commit to:

- Zero tolerance for child exploitation or abuse
- Prohibition of child labor within all projects
- Protection of children's dignity and privacy
- Mandatory consent procedures for image use
- Safe and age-appropriate participation
- Continuous safeguarding training for teams
- Immediate reporting mechanisms in case of concern

We recognise that child protection is not a statement. It is a permanent responsibility.

8. Ethics and Neutrality

Fair Future Foundation operates in full respect of:

- Local laws
- Cultural identities
- Religious traditions
- Community values

We are strictly non-political and non-denominational. We reject all forms of discrimination based on ethnicity, religion, gender, origin or social status.

Our work is guided by respect, simplicity and action.

9. Transparency and Financial Responsibility

The Foundation is entirely volunteer-driven. No salaries are distributed. More than 93% of donated funds are materially engaged in field operations. Accounts are audited annually and validated without restriction. Transparency is not a communication strategy. It is a structural obligation.

10. Responsible Use and Protection of Medical Data

As a medical humanitarian foundation, we collect and process health-related data only when necessary for clinical care, prevention programs, epidemiological monitoring or program evaluation.

Medical data is sensitive. Its protection is a matter of dignity.

We apply the following principles:

- **Data minimization**
Only information strictly required for medical or operational purposes is collected.
- **Confidentiality**
Access to medical records is restricted to authorised personnel.
All team members and community health agents are trained in patient confidentiality.
- **Secure storage**
Medical records, whether physical or digital, are stored securely with controlled access.
- **Anonymization**
When data is used for reporting, research or impact assessment, identifying elements are removed unless explicit consent has been obtained.
- **Informed consent**
Patients or guardians are informed of the purpose of data collection. Medical care is never conditional upon participation in research or communication activities.

Our data practices comply with applicable local regulations and are guided by international medical ethics standards.

Protecting medical data is part of protecting the patient.


