Communication and Cooperation are the Keys!

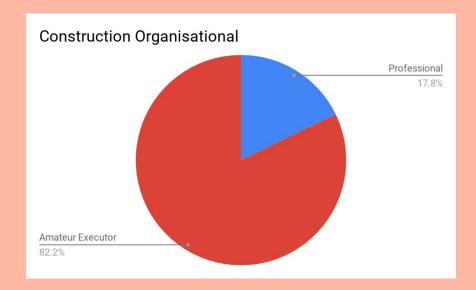
Mbinudita School construction comes with unique challenges that can test the comprehension of even the experience of the executors, project managers, and donors.

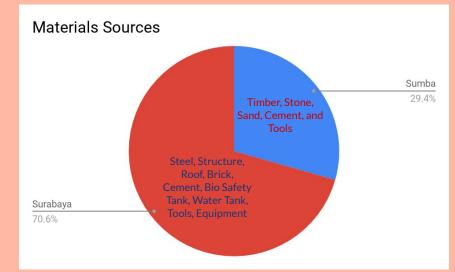

The Mbinudita project coordinator reporting the issues and the potential risks of the Project by data, explanation, and documentations to the Donors, Committee, and local participant to get help and solutions.

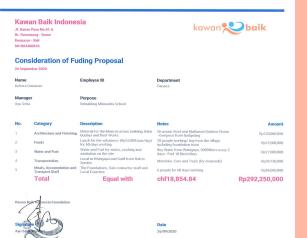
- 1. The expertise required to guide and support the construction process. We called the local experts and supplier representatives to be engaged. The suppliers have delegated some staff to help our site manager and teach the villager during the foundation marking, structure erection, and MEP part. They work as half volunteers, meals, mover, and accommodation financed by the foundation.
- 2. We build the temporary house on the site for the crew to be the temporary residential, to reduced the overruns of cost, time, and energy. Improve the facility by providing the water, electricity, and foods from the capital of Sumba and some from Bali.
- 3. The design itself is adapted to the Mbinudita landscape, life spends of the building, it's unique and strong. The material came from in/out of the island, most of them are coming from Java. The various basic materials we received from local sources and we support the transportation cost.

- → Mbinudita Monitoring part II by Kawan Baik Indonesia Foundation and Fair Future Foundation in Sumba during structure erection and exterior building.
- → Communicate with Committee (local participant) and Government for the future collaboration and participation for the School operations and others programs for communities.

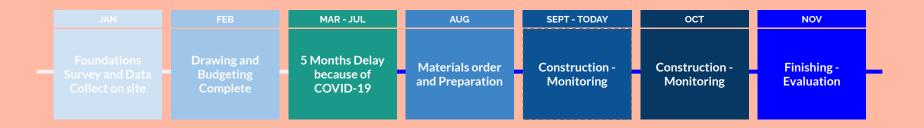
